We distribute delicious, chef-prepared meals, along with pre-selected, fresh protein, dairy, produce, and pantry groceries to women on most Wednesdays—no qualifications or fees required.

Drive-up service starts at 12:00 PM and ends at 2:00 PM. We strive to have all advertised items available until 2:00 PM. If demand exceeds supply, we offer substitutions. We recommend arriving early!

Please join the car line at N Normandie St, arriving from W Boone Ave. A member of our traffic team will greet you, ask questions to understand your needs and direct you forward.

To ensure fairness, if you cut in line at any other point, you will be asked to leave and join the end of the line. Refraining from doing so will result in being refused service.

We work as a community grounded in mutual respect, prioritizing the safety of staff, volunteers, and clients above all. Please adhere to the following etiquette when accessing our services...

- * Please arrive with a cleared-out trunk or cargo area, as you will receive a generous amount!
- * Show respect to our team members in both words and actions. Harsh, loud, or profane language is inappropriate and unacceptable.
- * Remain in your vehicle unless you are asked to exit.
- * Stay engaged by suspending phone calls, smoking, and other distractions until you have exited the line.
- * Participants and guests who are under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs will not be served.
- * Use your own voice when communicating. While men are permitted in the vehicles, our services are specifically for women and children. Therefore, all communication will be directed to women.
- * Kindly leave pets at home. Trained service animals are always welcome.
